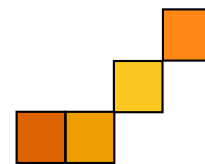




Utah Art Education Association National Conference Scholarship



1. The deadline for all scholarship applications is Dec 1, 2014. (No exceptions)
2. Please refer to the criteria below for eligibility requirements. In addition, please refer to the checklist and be sure you have all of the supporting documents necessary before submitting your application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. Type or print (in dark blue or black ink only) legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered.
4. Winners of the scholarship will be notified no later than Jan 15, 2015.

Purpose: The Utah Art Education Association (UAEA) works to provide training and networking opportunities for art educators throughout Utah. This scholarship will assist qualified teachers in becoming more involved with the National Art Education Association (NAEA) and receiving the benefit of training and networking on a national level.

Award Components: Each scholarship recipient will receive NAEA 2015 conference registration and a shared hotel room for the duration of the conference.

Award Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a licensed teacher currently working in a public or private K-12 school or institute of higher education in Utah.
2. Applicant must be a current UAEA and NAEA member.
3. Applicant must have a proven record of attendance and participation at the UAEA annual conference. Priority will be given to applicants who have presented sessions at the UAEA conference.
4. Applicant must commit to attend the 2015 NAEA conference. (Airfare and other transportation, meals, special sessions, and other miscellaneous costs are not covered by UAEA or by this scholarship, and will be the full responsibility of the applicant.)
5. Applicant must plan and implement the "Utah meet-up" during the 2015 NAEA conference, under the direction of the UAEA Co-Presidents.
6. Applicant must commit to present a session at the 2016 UAEA spring conference regarding their experience at the NAEA conference.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form
2. Letter of intent addressed to the UAEA board.
3. Letter of support from principal or other school administrator
4. Letter of recommendation from District Art Coordinator
5. Character reference in the form of a letter of recommendation
6. Professional Resume or CV
7. Portfolio including at least 3 samples of applicant's art work and 3 examples of student work (this will not be returned to you)

Deadline: The deadline for the application is Dec 1, 2014. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered. No emailed or incomplete applications will be considered.

Announcement of Scholarship recipient: Jan 15, 2015

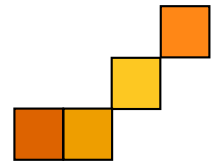
Dissemination of Funds: The funds will be paid directly to NAEA and selected hotels and may not be used as a reimbursement of any kind.

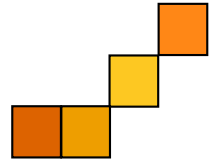

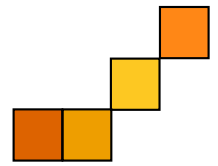
