Catherine Ford was a Utah Art Educator of the Year and was also a strong advocate for the arts in the state of Utah. She passed away in 2002 at the age of 48. The UAEA established this scholarship in her honor and to help students continue their studies within the arts at the college level.

To apply for this scholarship, please meet the following requirements:

1. Students nominated for this scholarship must be a high school senior who will be continuing their studies in art at the college level.

1. The nominating teacher should write a letter of recommendation. This letter should address: a) the student's experience and merit in art; b)reason for the nomination; c) student need .

2. The nominated student will submit an artist statement of no more than 350 words.

3. A digital portfolio of five (5) images should also be submitted with this application. Please <u>do not</u> include an image of the student artist, but should instead focus on the artistic work of the student. Optionally, two additional detail images may be submitted showing details of one or two of the works. It is suggested that the digital portfolio be put together in a powerpoint or pdf presentation that is small enough to be emailed with this application. At the very least, jpg files should be attached.
